Present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to initiate proceedings under Section 51(3) of Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, against respondent No.4, who has embezzled huge amount of Gram Panchayat and to take action on the basis of show cause notice dated 29.06.2018 and legal notice dated 23.08.2018.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contended that the petitioner, who is complainant in this case, had levelled allegations against respondent No.4 and the matter was enquired by Block Development and Panchayat Officer, who submitted his report Annexure-P1 and some of the allegations against respondent No.4 were found to be correct and thereafter, show cause notice (Annexure-P2) was issued by Deputy Commissioner, Panipat, but still no action is being taken.
