By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to consider the case of the petitioners for promotion to the posts of Superintendent Grade-II/Grade-I in the light of judgment passed by this Court, vide Annexure P-5 and P-8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case, respondent No.2 is directed to take a decision on the representation dated 05.03.2015 (Annexure P-9) moved by the petitioners.

Heard.

In view of the statement made, the Court is not inclined to issue notice of motion, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to take a decision on the representation dated

05.03.2015 (Annexure P-9), within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
