The petitioner is 4th vendee of Plot No.103-D in Atam Nagar Co-operative House Building Society Limited at Ludhiana to whom the land was allotted by the Ludhiana Improvement Trust, Ludhiana. The petitioner has purchased the above-stated plot for consideration from the previous owner. The Society has allocated new membership No.1692 to the petitioner vide letter No.1773 dated 09.05.2018.

The short grievance in the instant writ petition is that though the petitioner has deposited the requisite charges for execution of Conveyance Deed but the respondents are sitting tight over the matter.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of relief sought by her, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to verify the above-mentioned claim of the petitioner and take an appropriate decision regarding execution of the Conveyance Deed within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
