The writ petition involves various questions of facts regarding lack of basic amenities or infrastructure facilities in Sector-2, IMT, Bawal. The petitioner claims that she is not liable to pay interest for the double storey Booth No.20, Sector-2, IMT, Bawal for want of basic amenities/facilities. Whereas the Estate Officer has turned down her request on the strength of a report which refers to availability of basic amenities/facilities.

Since the petitioner is questioning the said report, may be in part, we are of the view that such like disputed questions of facts can be resolved by the higher authorities in the respondent-Corporation. The writ petition is thus disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal before the Managing Director of the respondent-Corporation who shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law and after obtaining a fact-finding report, within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
