In the present writ petition, the petitioner is seeking the interest on the delayed payment of the retiral benefits in view of the law laid down by this Court in **R.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab, 1997 (3) RSJ 318.**

Notice of motion was issued on 27.09.2018.

Mr. Aman Sharma, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a time bound manner in view of the settled proposition of law.

Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the grant of prayer as made by counsel for the petitioner today in the Court.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice

dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
