Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the pensionary benefits/retiral benefits to them after count their daily wages/work charge services which rendered prior to regularization, along with arrears with interest @ 24% p.a. AND to grant increments for the service rendered on daily wage basis after calculation the arrears with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though a legal notice was made to the respondents on 10.08.2018 (P-4) but till date neither any reply to the said legal notice has been received nor any final order has

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been passed by the concerned Department. He further submits that they feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said legal notice (P-4) in the light of judgment bearing CWP No.3758 of 2008 captioned as ***Gurpal Singh vs. State of Haryana & ors. decided on 01.09.2009***, within some specified period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 10.08.2018 (P-4) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per ***Gurpal Singh's case (Supra)***, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
