Prayer in the application is for withdrawal of the main writ petition.

Main case

Challenge in the instant writ petition was to an order dated 19.7.2017, Annexure P50, passed by the Financial

Commissioner, Revenue, Punjab and in terms of which, the matter relating to partition proceedings *inter se* the parties had been remanded back to the Commissioner. Further challenge was to an order dated 26.9.2017, Annexure P53, whereby a review petition preferred by the petitioner has been declined by the Financial Commissioner.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner makes a statement at the bar that he has instructions not to pursue the instant writ petition.

As per statement and prayer made by the learned counsel, writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.
