Through instant petition preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the balance of the legitimate retiral dues amounting to ₹1,27,166/- along-with interest @18% per annum on the delayed payments as well as on the afore-said amount.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.1, to decide the legal notice dated 22.08.2018 (Annexure P-3), within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.1-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Moti Bagh, District Patiala, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 22.08.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to take a conscious decision, in accordance with law, Rules and Regulations as well as various instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
