By virtue of instant petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix his pension as per the notification dated 17.04.2009 as per Sr. No. 20 of the concordance table Annexure A-1 provided in Rule 6 (5) of the notification dated 17.04.2009 (P-2) with further direction to grant interest @ 18% on the delayed payment of the arrears.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that though a legal notice dated 22.06.2018 (P-11) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply to the notice has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. She further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the afore-said legal notice within some time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents or any other competent officer to deal with the matter, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 22.06.2018 (P-11) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
