The petitioner is sole proprietor of Laxmi Sadan, HUDA bye-pass, Sector-19, Rewari. The said premises is being used by her as 'marriage palace'. The premises of the petitioner is adjoining a revenue *rasta* which is over 33 feet wide, as explained in the site-plan (P-1). Since petitioner wanted basic amenities, she is said to have deposited a sum of Rs.11,75,125/- with HUDA towards external development charges as per the demand letter dated 23.03.2009. The grievance in the instant writ petition is that despite deposit of that amount, HUDA authorities have not constructed 33 feet wide road which is the solitary access to the petitioner's property. Such a claim has been raised by the petitioner vide legal notice dated 27.08.2018 also.

The instant writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula and the Estate Officer, HUDA, Rewari to decide the above-mentioned claim of the

petitioner, as contained in the legal notice dated 27.08.2018, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
