Through the instant petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider/decide the legal notice dated 17.01.2018 (P-12) and relying upon similar Full Bench judgment “*Kesar Singh vs. State of Punjab & ors.*” 1988 (5) SLR 27 (P-5) and smiliar situated employees had already been given similar benefits of pension and pensionary benefits and paid arrears of pension with interest @ 12%.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents particularly respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 17.01.2018

(P-12) in light of the judgment in ***Kesar Singh's case (Supra)*** (P-5), within some stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly respondent No.2 - Managing Director, Haryana Seeds Corporation Ltd., Bays No.3-6, Sector 2, Panchkula (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 17.01.2018 (P-12) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order in view of ***Kesar Singh's case (Supra)***, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
