By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-8) and legal notice dated 08.12.2016 (Annexure P-10).

Learned counsel states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-8) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is

admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
