The grievance raised in this petition is that the tender submitted by the petitioner in response to NIT dated 16.03.2017 has not been finalized as yet and without finalizing the same the tender has been re-advertised.

2. Mr. J.S. Puri, learned counsel for the Food Corporation of India, has put in appearance on the strength of caveat and on the basis of instructions from Mr. Abhishek Sinha, AGM (Contract), FCI, Punjab states that a decision was taken to scrap the tender on 27.09.2018.

3. In view of the aforesaid statement made by Mr. Puri, learned counsel for the respondents, the cause of action in this writ petition does not survive any further and the same is rendered infructuous and accordingly stands dismissed.

4. However, a copy of the decision dated 27.09.2018 scrapping the tender shall be delivered to the petitioner within 24 hours of an application being made by him in this regard before the authorities.
