DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that appointments to the post of Salesman are being made contrary to the procedure laid down and without issuing public notice. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioners have made representations to the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ludhiana, which are annexed as Annexures P-5 and P-6 with the petition and copies thereof have also been sent to Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ludhiana. Learned counsel also contends that not only violation of the Rules and procedure is there but a very short period of two hours has been given to invite applications.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case directions are issued to the respondents to consider their representations.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take necessary action on the representations of the petitioners dated 29.12.2017 (Annexure P-5 and P-6) in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

It is also directed that no appointment on the post of Salesman be made till the decision is taken on the representations of the petitioners.

Disposed of accordingly.
