KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Mr. Har Naresh Singh Gill, learned counsel for the respondents, on the basis of instructions from respondent No.1-Chief Engineer, Punjab Agricultural University, states that period of debarment of the petitioner shall be counted from 4.7.2016, the date on which initial order for debarment of two years was passed. He further states that the tender in question has not been allotted to anyone and the same shall stand cancelled and fresh notice inviting tender shall be issued in which the petitioner shall be free to participate.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the respondents and the fact that two years’ period for which the petitioner was debarred has already come to an end, the petition is rendered infructuous and accordingly stands disposed of.
