In this writ petition, the petitioner challenges order dated 27.1.2007 Annexure P-3, dismissing the petitioner as per the Bipartite Settlement Annexure P-1, pursuant to the charge-sheet dated 9.5.2006, questioning the constitutional validity of Clause 5(j), 6(a) to 6(i), 8(a), 8(b) of the respondent Bank's Bipartite Settlement dated 10.4.2002.

Upon questioned as to whether any appeal had been filed against order Annexure P-3, counsel for the petitioner submits that in a separate writ petition bearing No. CWP-6478 of 2009, the validity of order Annexure P-3 passed by the Appellate Authority, has been challenged.

In view of said circumstances, when counsel confronted with the maintainability of present petition, he seeks

permission to withdraw the instant writ petition, at this stage with liberty to challenge the constitutional validity of the above said provisions by seeking amendment in the writ petition which has already been filed by the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
