Learned State counsel taken the stand that during the pendency of the writ petition, retiral benefits have already been released to the petitioner rendering the present writ petition infructuous.

In view of above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to make payment on account of interest at the rate of 9% per annum on the delayed payment within a period of two months.
