KRISHNA MURARI, C.J. (Oral)

Contends that the petitioner had even earlier approached this Court vide CWP No.19743 of 2018, which had since been withdrawn vide order dated 09.08.2018 so as to enable the petitioner to pursue the representations it had made and were pending before the authorities. It is urged that even though, post order dated 09.08.2018, the petitioner has repeatedly represented to the respondents vide representations dated 21.08.2018 (Annexure P6) 23.08.2018 (Annexure P7) and 20.09.2018 (Annexure P8), but to no avail. He submits that owing to inaction of the respondent-authorities, the interest of the petitioner is severely effected.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, we deem it expedient to dispose of this petition, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondent-authorities to consider and deal with the representations that are pending consideration of the respondent-authorities and pass appropriate

orders in accordance with law, within a period of 10 days from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to assert that a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons in support thereof.
