The instant Civil Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India. The petitioner has sought the issuance of writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner in view of the order dated 11.08.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by Division Bench of this Hon'ble court in LPA No. 961 of 2014 titled as Jagroop Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others and further direction may also be issued to the respondents to confirm the petitioner as Inspector w.e.f. 27.07.1976 on completion of two years service as Inspector and allowing him subsequent claims consequential to the above in the light of claim of Rajinder Singh, ASI allowed vide order dated 18.02.2011 (Annexure P-2).

At the very outset, it has been pointed out by learned State counsel Mr. C.S. Bakshi, that the case of the petitioner with regard to his

confirmation being effected from 27.07.1976 as well as for regularization

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or ad hoc promotion and the grant of other consequential benefits i.e. promotion from the rank of DSP to SP and to the further higher post was considered but was rejected vide order dated 31.03.2017 passed by Director General of Police, Haryana.

In view of the aforesaid order dated 31.03.2017 passed by the Director General of Police, Haryana, instant petition has rendered infructuous and if at all the petitioner is required to challenge the aforesaid order dated 31.03.2017.

Accordingly, instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous but with liberty to the effect that if petitioner feels aggrieved against the order dated 31.03.2017 referred to above, to lay a challenge thereto.
