This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to regularize the services of the petitioner in terms of the policy instructions dated 18.01.1995, 23.01.2001, 15.12.2006 and 17.11.2011 (Annexures P-7, P-8, P-9 and P-12 respectively) issued by the Government of Punjab along with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.1- Principal Secretary, Department of Education, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to

consider and decide the notice dated 07.07.2017 (Annexure P-13).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1- Principal Secretary, Department of Education, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to consider and decide the notice dated 07.07.2017 (Annexure P-13) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
