Petitioner concededly was engaged as a Chowkidar on contract basis to work at PHC Kaniawali under the National Rural Health Mission Scheme. His services were dispensed with “as no required” as apparent from the letter dated 27.01.2017 (P-3). Thus the petitioner had sought the quashing of order dated 27.01.2017 (P-3) with a further prayer for Mandamus to direct the respondents to reinstate the petitioner with continuity and full back wages.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner at length, no ground for interference is made out.

It is not the case of the petitioner that he has been replaced by appointing someone on contract basis. The action of dispensing also cannot be termed as malafide. The dispensing of the engagement of the petitioner

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
