1. By way of instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has challenged the notice taking possession of the assets dated 30.8.2018 (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
