The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, by way of Public Interest Litigation (PIL), seeking direction to the respondents to immediately constitute board and to enact special legislation for governing practice of Yoga and Naturopathy in the States of Haryana and Punjab in the lines of special enactments by the States of Tamilnadu, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Maharashtra with a further direction to the respondents to take note of the concerns shown regarding the system in the letters dated 09.12.1998 and 10.06.2006 (appended as Annexures P-1 & P-2, respectively).

2. The petitioner, who appears in-person states that insofar as the States of Haryana is concerned, they have prepared the policy, whereas, in

the case of State of Punjab, the matter is under consideration. Accordingly, the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition.
