JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to expeditiously consider and decide the representation/application dated 07.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) and by releasing the salary due to the petitioner w.e.f. 24.01.2012 to 27.06.2013.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (P-2) in a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation (P-2) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules and

instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
