JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to calculate the service period from the day of his employment dated 31.05.1990 till retirement on superannuation on 30.04.2017 and to re-fix his pay by giving increments as per latest pay commission and to re-calculate his gratuity and other retiral benefits forthwith as no action has been taken by the respondents despite service of legal notice dated 24.05.2018 (P-5) duly served upon them.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents particularly respondents No.2 & 3 to decide the abovesaid legal notice (P-5), within some specified period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly respondents No.2 & 3 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 24.05.2018 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
