By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to pay the higher grade of Rs.110-250 as revised from time to time to JBT teachers in accordance with the qualifications possessed by them.

Heard.

As per reply dated 20.02.2017 filed on behalf of the State, the claim of the petitioners has been settled in terms of decision in LPA No.504 of 2012 and LPA No.136 of 2013, decided on 22.05.2014.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

At this stage, it needs to be mentioned that the reply is categoric with regard to claim of petitioner Nos.1 to 3 whereas there is no specific mention qua petitioner No.4. It is ordered that the case of

petitioner No.4 be also considered in the light of decision in LPA Nos.504-2012 and 136-2013. In case, on consideration, the competent authority finds petitioner No.4 eligible subject to the condition laid in Annexure R-1 and above said LPAs, in such eventuality, the necessary benefit be allowed to petitioner No.4, if it has not been allowed so far, expeditiously.
