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**ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)**

In compliance to the order passed on the previous date of hearing, i.e. 3.4.2018, learned State counsel submits that services of late Sh. Rampal have since been regularised w.e.f. 1.2.1999. He has produced a copy of the order dated 5.4.2018, passed by the District Education Officer, Jind, in this regard, which is taken on record as Mark A. Further, in reference to Annexure R-1, dated 9.4.2018, appended with the affidavit of Director Elementary Education Haryana, Panchkula, which too has been filed today in Court, it is submitted that instructions have also been issued to the concerned authorities to release the consequential benefits of the deceased at the earliest. He submits that the entire arrears, admissible to deceased-Rampal (husband of the petitioner) shall be disbursed within a period of four weeks from today.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, subject,

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however, to the claim of the petitioner as regards interest on the delayed payment, as also for appointment on compassionate ground.

As to this, learned State counsel submits that in the event, the petitioner would make any such claim/representation, the same shall be considered and dealt with by the respondent authorities. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.
