By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to consider their claim for selection and appointments as Hindi Mistresses in view of the fact that large number of candidates including respondent No.3 who were lower in merit to the petitioners had already been given appointments as Hindi Master/Mistresses.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 28.12.2017 (Annexure P-17) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 28.12.2017 (Annexure P-17). In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the

conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
