1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the notice issued under Section 13(2) of The Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
