Petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents to treat his training period as duty period for all intent and purpose and further to release pay and other consequential benefit as per judgment (Annexure P-3).

A perusal of the judgment dated 15.02.2018 passed in CWP No.3429 of 2018 (Annexure P-3) shows that petitioners were employed as Conductors with the respondent/department in the year 2008 and before they were assigned duties, they required to undergo a training. But since they were not paid any emoluments for the training period, they approached the Labour Court. Vide Award dated 17.09.2014, learned labour Court has accepted the claims of the petitioners by giving directions to the respondent that the training period of the petitioners be treated as duty period and salary had to be paid by the department. A representation (Annexure P-5) has been moved by the petitioners for the same cause of action but no action has been taken in this regard.
