The petitioner has approached this Court by way of **CWP No. 24175 of 2016** titled as **Narender Singh** Vs. **Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd.** which was disposed on 23.11.2016 directing the respondents to consider the legal notice of the petitioner within the prescribed period. Thereafter, the legal notice was considered by the Chairman/Managing Director, UHBVN and the request of the petitioner for grant of compensation has been declined on the ground that the respondents are not responsible for the accident of electrocution rather the accident happened due to the negligence of the deceased. In view thereof, the only remedy available for the petitioner is to file a Civil Suit as it would require evidence to prove as to whether the accident had occurred due to the negligence of the deceased or the respondents.

Faced with these observations, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file Civil Suit.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.
