The instant writ petition was filed challenging the order dated 9.10.2017 (Annexure P-17) passed by the Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab and in terms of which an inquiry had been marked to a police official on a complaint made by the wife of the petitioner.

As per pleadings and case set up by the petitioner the complaint had been lodged by the estranged wife so as to implead the petitioner in case FIR No.151 dated 31.8.2016 under sections 457, 380, 411 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Phase-I, Mohali. Assertion made in the petition was that inquiry had been marked to a handpicked officer.

During the course of hearing today, counsel states that the trial that had ensued in pursuance to FIR No.151 dated 31.8.2016, already stands concluded and as such, he has instructions not to pursue the instant petition.

As per statement made by counsel representing the petitioner, instant petition is dismissed as not pressed.
