The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners who are eight in numbers, posted as Lab Attendants and are aggrieved against the transfers/adjustment/posted in the schools against vacancy, on account of less strength of science students.

The grouse of the petitioners as such is that they have certificates of the relevant schools that the strength of the students is more and, therefore, their transfers were liable to be cancelled.

Reliance has been placed upon letters issued by respondents No.3 to 7 (Annexure P-3 colly.). Similarly, reference is also made to the letter dated 13.07.2018 (Annexure P-4), whereby there is a ban on transfers and posting, on account of special revision of Photo Electoral role work.

The relevant issues which are sought to be raised by the petitioners is a matter, which the petitioners should agitate before competent authority, for the cancellation of the transfer orders. The post on which the petitioners are posted and seeking quashing of transfer orders, the same can be raised before the competent authority.

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It is settled principle that transfer orders are not to be interfered with by this Court until there is some malafide or some statutory right in favour of the petitioners, which the counsel could not as such demonstrate.

In such circumstances, counsel does not press the present writ petition and prays for liberty to approach the respondents for the necessary relief.

Disposed of accordingly.
