The petitioner is alien to the proceedings under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Land Act, 1961. Therefore, the instant petition ought to have been dismissed on the issue of locus alone. However, keeping in view the fact that the proceedings under Section 7 of the Act are directed against the unauthorized occupants and enhance the cause of preservation of village land and further since it is expected of every authority to expeditiously dispose of the matters before it, we dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the competent authority to decide the proceedings under Section 7 of the Act as expeditiously as possible. It is also directed that no untoward adjournment shall be granted to either of the parties.
