The petitioner was promoted as Lecturer in Maths from the rank of Math Mistress on 05.06.2008 by the Department of Secondary Education, Punjab. She was posted in Government Senior Secondary School, Bhagu, District Fazilka and on 14.5.2010 she was adjusted in Government Senior Secondary School (Boys), Abohar, District Fazilka.

The petitioner has impugned her transfer from the aforesaid school at Abohar to Government Senior Secondary School, Jhurar, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib vide order dated 31.08.2018/26.09.2018 (Annexure P-6).

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, no ground for interference is made out. The petitioner had stayed for almost eight years at

the aforesaid school in Fazilka except for intermediate period of one month. Petitioner having a longest stay at the school and even otherwise as per the service conditions liable to serve anywhere in the State of Punjab, cannot raise a grievance with regard to her transfer to a school in the adjoining District. It is well settled principle of law that the transfer is an incidence and not a condition of service and violation, if any, of the transfer policy does not vest an enforceable right with the employee.

Dismissed.
