This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the Bank to restore the possession of the secured asset to the petitioner and to issue No Dues Certificate.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since the petitioner has not approached the Bank at the first instance and liberty be granted to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation before the respondent-Bank. However, it was further prayed that a time bound direction may be issued to the respondent-Bank to decide the same.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation before the respondent-Bank. In the event of such a

representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the respondent-Bank expeditiously.
