JASWANT SINGH J.(Oral)

The petitioner is serving as a Lecturer in Chemistry with the Department of Secondary Education, Punjab. He has impugned the order dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) whereby he has been transferred from his place of posting at GSSS, N.T.C., Rajpura, District Patiala to GSSS, Chhajli, District Sangrur.

Heard.

It is not disputed that the petitioner on promotion as Lecturer in Chemistry in the year 2011 has remained posted at GSSS, N.T.C. Rajpura, District Patiala. He has been transferred now after 7-½ years of his place of posting. Petitioner having a longest stay at the school and even otherwise as per the service conditions liable to serve anywhere in the State of Punjab,

cannot raise a grievance with regard to his transfer to a school in the adjoining District. It is well settled principle of law that the transfer is an incidence and not a condition of service and violation, if any, of the transfer policy does not vest a enforceable right with the employee.

Dismissed.
