On May 04, 2017, this Court had passed the following order:-

***“ There is yet another request for adjournment by
counsel for the petitioners. On the last date, the
following order was passed:-***

***“ On request of learned counsel for the
petitioners, adjourned to 04.05.2017.***

***As the instant petition is pending for
motion hearing since 2014, it is made clear that
no further adjournment shall be granted.***

***A photocopy of this order be placed on the
file of another connected cases.”***

***In these circumstances, I see no reason to grant
further time. However, on the request of counsel for***

***the petitioners, these cases are adjourned to 21.11.2017
subject to payment of ₹2500/- as costs in each case to be
