In the present writ petition, the petitioner submits that even though vide order dated 10.01.2018 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner has been given retrospective promotion as ASI from 19.09.1996 but his pay and consequential pension, which were to be revised, is not being done by the respondents despite repeated requests and reminders.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner in respect of his claim, has made representations dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and 19.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) to the respondents but these representations are still pending and have not been decided. Learned counsel states that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide his representations dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and 19.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) in respect of the claim, which has been made in the present writ petition as well.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim made by the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of

with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and 19.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any re-fixation of salary and other pension, the same should also be done within a period of next three months.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
