Petitioner seeks directions to respondents to release him for six weeks on agricultural parole under the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988.

It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner requested the jail authorities to release the petitioner on parole but the same was neither allowed nor her case was forwarded to the competent authorities.

State in its reply filed on 29.10.2018 has taken the stand that petitioner is undergoing life imprisonment in some other case. State has also given the list of other cases pending against the petitioner i.e., undergone, acquitted and discharged cases.

It is further stated that the petitioner was released on three weeks furlough on 29.12.2017 and surrendered after the expiry of furlough period on jail gates on 20.1.2018. It is stated that one new case in FIR No. 61 dated 28.1.2014 under Section 61/1/14 of the Excise Act has been registered against the petitioner at Police Station Jind. It is further stated that 30 days remission has been forfeited from his earned remission which was vide order No. 3212 dated 6.3.2018.

In any case, after hearing both the parties, this Court will not go into the merits of the case. State does not say that the petitioner has submitted any fresh application for parole.

In the circumstance, present petition is disposed of with an observation that the petitioner can file fresh application for parole before the jail authorities stating the grounds on which he is seeking parole. If such application is filed, Superintendent, District Jail, Jind shall process the same as per rules and forward the same to the competent authorities.

Disposed of with above said observation.
