This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 11.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh (in short 'Tribunal') vide which the application filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that certain points were raised before the Tribunal, however, the same have not been dealt with and prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Tribunal to file the review petition pointing out the aforesaid facts.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to him, in accordance with law.
