The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, for directing the respondents to grant parole to the petitioner in case FIR No.194 dated 19.05.2012 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 302, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Panipat, District Panipat.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deepak Sharma, Superintendent, District Prison, Faridabad on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 along with Annexure R-1 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no written order, passed by Superintendent Jail, Faridabad for declining the

parole of the petitioner, as he orally declined the parole.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Jail Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad to accept the application for parole and examine the same on merits and submit the same before the Competent Authority for passing appropriate orders. When such application is filed, the same shall be dealt with and disposed of within the time frame fixed as per Haryana Government instructions.
