The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to consider and decide the issue with regard to renewal of the Arms licence No.2245/DM/LDH/JGSD/Sep-1998 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the representation made by the petitioner is still pending and no action has been taken. He further submits that under the similar circumstances, one Amar Singh has approached this Court by way of filing CWP No.9333 of 2015 and the same was disposed of with a direction to consider and take necessary action on the application filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner has been

acquitted in the case registered against him and his representation is still pending. He would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to consider his pending representation.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to take final decision on representation dated 04.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.
