Petitioner has challenged the communication dated 28.10.2013 (Annexure P-12) by which he has been informed that he is medically unfit for the purpose of selection and appointment to the post of constable (GD) in CRPF and further direction to the respondents to consider their own letter dated 01.02.2013 (AnnexureP-8)

Petitioner is a candidate for recruitment to the post of Constable (GD) in CRPF. Process of selection commenced in the year 2011. Initially petitioner was found unfit on the ground of medical. Thereafter in the review medical, he was found fit. Thus, he was placed in the reserve list. Recruitment of the year 2011 was the subject matter before the Delhi High Court and certain directions were given. Consequently, petitioner's name was also required to be considered in the year 2013. Therefore, respondents subjected petitioner to medical examination in the month of April 2013 in which it was found that petitioner was medically unfit. Thereafter, petitioner was subjected to review medical. Even in the review medical, he was found

medically unfit on 16.04.2013.

In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the communication dated 28.10.2013 (Annexure P-12).

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
