Accordingly, the petition is disposed of at this stage only with a direction to the respondents that if indeed any such representation, as indicated above, is pending consideration, the same shall be considered and dealt with and appropriate orders in accordance with law shall be passed thereupon within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
