RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has come directly to this Court without availing his remedy before the Transferring Authority.

2. In view of the repeated orders of the Supreme Court and this Court that in transfer matters the person aggrieved must take recourse to his departmental remedy before approaching the Court. The petitioner has not even made a representation to his superior officer.

3. In these circumstances, the petitioner is relegated to his remedy before the Transferring Authority. He may make a representation and the competent authority would decide the same after hearing the grievance of the petitioner and take a final decision whether to transfer him or not.

4. Let a final decision be taken within 10 days from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, a favourable decision is made, then there would be no need to pass an order.

However, in case the decision has to be maintained, then brief reasons may be supplied in writing to the petitioner.

5. With these observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.
