Challenge in this writ petition has been laid to the order (Annexure P-2) whereby a sum of Rs.80,517/- has been ordered to be recovered from the petitioner.

As per the reply, all the retiral dues admissible to the petitioner along with recovered amount of Rs.80517/- have since been released in favour of the petitioner as per the description given in the table in paragraph No.3 of the reply dated 08.09.2016 filed through Executive Engineer, Township Division No.1, RSD, Shahpurkandi Township.

In this view of the matter the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
