Petitioner while working as Upper Division Clerk with the erstwhile Punjab State Electricity Board was granted benefit of general pay revision w.e.f. 1.1.1996. It transpires that some junior persons who had opted for availing the benefit of the pay revision from dates post 1.1.1996 came about to be withdrawing a higher pay in the same functional pay scale of the post of UDC. Resultantly, the petitioner and his another junior Vijay Kumar were drawing less pay than some of their juniors in the same pay scale which was legally permissible. In case of Vijay Kumar, his pay was upgraded in the year 2005 equal to said juniors on the basis of acute hardship. The petitioner by filing the present petition after 12 years is claiming similar upgradation as granted to his junior Vijay Kumar.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel petitioner prays

pursue his remedy before the Department.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
