AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J.

1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the order dated 22.9.2018, Annexure P.1, passed by Debt Recovery Tribunal-III, Chandigarh. A further writ in the nature of Mandamus be issued for withdrawal of the auction notice dated 26.8.2018, Annexure P.2. It is also prayed that the respondent Nos.2 and 3 be directed to enforce the RBI guidelines dated 12.7.2004 in letter and spirit in view of the agricultural advance.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to them in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
