The petitioner was tried in a case registered vide FIR No.521 dated 28.9.2008 under Sections 365, 366, 376 (G), 323, 506 & 473 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 [for short 'the IPC'] at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh. He was convicted and sentenced by the Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh. His appeal was dismissed by this Court. He has made a prayer for extension of his parole w.e.f. 8.10.2018 on the same surety and security already furnished by him to the District Magistrate to attend his wife who has recently delivered a child on 15.9.2018. The petitioner has been released on parole for looking after his wife and is now seeking extension of parole on the ground that the newly born child is weak and requires full care.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after analyzing the facts and circumstances of the case, am of the considered opinion that this is not a ground for extending the period of parole and hence, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
